ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

DESIGNATION OF FILINGS BETWEEN
DISTRICT COURTS OF THE COUNTIES

Came on to be considered Effective January 1, 2007 the matter of allocating filings between the 33rd and the 424th Judicial District Courts in the counties of the concurrent jurisdiction of the Judicial Districts.

The Courts therefore enter the following Order and, accordingly, it is **ORDERED AND DECREED** that all cases shall be filed in one or the other of the Courts according to the county of venue as follows:

In the 33rd District Court: Burnet and San Saba counties; and

In the 424th District Court: Llano and Blanco counties.


Notwithstanding the Court of filing, the Courts have concurrent jurisdiction and automatic bench exchange as deemed necessary by the Judges.

All cases now docketed in a Court other than specified above are hereby transferred to the correct Court as specified and the Clerk is ORDERED to effect the transfers on their dockets.


